QUILT SHOW ENTRY INFORMATION & RULES

DIVISIONS & CATEGORIES:

Challenge Quilts: Division 2011

Challenge quilts, any category may be made by one or more persons,

2011-01 - '2011, a quilt odyssey' - No size limitations, any technique. Give us your interpretation of the show's theme.

2011-02 - '2011, a space oddity' - No side of the quilt must be longer than 60". Must be odd and/or have SPACE in the quilt. Note: entrant must supply any special hanging gear.

2011-03 - 'Saving Planet Earth' – recycled items or theme in the quilt, no larger than 40" on any side, using any technique.

One Person Quilts: Division 101

All quilts in Division 101 must be constructed and quilted by only one person

101-H-01 - Any Size - Hand quilted

101-M-01 - Bed Sized - Pieced - Must have one side over 72" -

101-M-02 - Bed Sized - Appliquéd - Must have one side over 72" -

101-M-03 - Bed Sized - Mixed Techniques - must have one side over 72" - and containing a balanced mix of 2 techniques (example - piecing and appliqué)

101-M-11 - Wall Hanging - Pieced - No side shorter than 20" or longer than 72"

101-M-12 - Wall Hanging – Appliquéd - No side shorter than 20" or longer than 72"

101-M-13 - Wall Hanging - Mixed Technique - No side shorter than 20" or longer than 72"

101-M-21 - Miniature Quilt – Traditional (pieced or appliqué) - No side is longer than 20" -any technique - scale of design must be suited to the size of the quilt

101-AM-31 – Art Miniature Quilt - Original design using techniques and/or materials in a non-traditional manner. – No side is longer than 20" - any technique - scale of design must be suited to the size of the quilt.

101-A-99 - Art Quilt - Original design using techniques and/or materials in a non-traditional manner. No limitations on size, construction or finishing methods for this category.

101-F-01 - First Quilt Entry - any construction or finishing method allowed.

101-Y-01 - Youth Quilt - Any quilt made by one person who is 17 years old or younger. No limitations on size construction or finishing methods for this category.

101-CR-01 - Crazy Quilts - a unique conglomeration of randomly pieced fancy fabrics with embroidered embellishments on nearly every seam and patch.

Two Person Quilts: Division 201

All quilts in Division 201 must be constructed and quilted by only two people - If your group quilt fits into any of the categories above, replace 101- with 201. For example if 2 people have made a hand quilted quilt, put 201-H-01 as the Category on your entry form. Youth quilts in 2 person division must be made by 2 youths, 17 & younger.

Group Quilts: Division 301

All quilts in Division 301 must be constructed and quilted by more than two people, replace 101- with 301. For example, if your group has made a machine quilted, pieced wall hanging, put 301-M-11 as the Category on your entry form. Youth quilts in Group Division must be made by more than 2 youths, 17 and younger.

Guild Donation Quilts for 2011 or 2012: Division 501 (no charge for entry)

Guild may display information about their guild and/or the quilt, but may not sell tickets for the quilt. Please indicate on the entry form if the quilt is to be judged.

Garments & Accessories: Division 801

Includes any wearables, handbags, belts, etc. A dressmakers form or suitable hanging system to be supplied by the entrant.

Dolls & 3D Artwork: Division 901

Includes Dolls and 3D artwork. Stands and support structures to be supplied by entrant.

Category must be indicated on your entry form. The Quilt Show Committee has the final say on quilt category and may place a quilt in a more applicable category, or consolidate categories if there are insufficient entries.

SUBMISSION CRITERIA:

SLEEVES: No quilts will be accepted at check-in without a proper hanging sleeve! Miniature quilts must have a 2" or larger sleeve for hanging. All other quilts must have a 4" or larger sleeve for hanging stitched to the top of the quilt on the back. Quilts longer than 86" must have a second sleeve attached no more than 86" from the bottom of the quilt. Odd shaped quilts may be mounted on black fabric which has a 4" sleeve or entrant may supply a pre-approved hanging system.

LABELS: Each entry must have a label, which includes: your name, address, cell phone number, title of entry. Please SEW labels securely to back lower left corner of quilts. SEW labels securely to inside of garments and ATTACH SECURELY to dolls or 3-D items under their base. For judging, labels must be covered with fabric (baste in place - do not use pins) so that maker(s) of items will remain anonymous during judging. All names on front of a quilt or item must be covered for judging purposes. Covering may be removed after judging.

CARRYING BAG: Each entry must be brought to quilt take-in in a cloth carrying bag that is marked with the owner's name, address and telephone number.

CONDITION OF ENTRIES: All entries must be clean & in good condition with no sharp objects attached.

QUILT SHOW DEADLINES AND INFORMATION:

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- ▶ Each entry shall consist of: Completed Entry Form; Fees; A Clear Printed Photo of the Entry (Print entrant's name, entry title and dimensions of entry on the back of the photo); A Self Addressed Stamped Envelope.
- ▶ **All entry forms, photos, and applicable fees must be POSTMARKED by Friday, July 1, 2011.** Entry forms may be turned in on or before the June, 2011 QGGH meeting or mailed to:

Make checks payable to QGGH. Number of entries could be limited based on space considerations.

Confirmation of Acceptance and Check-in Information will be mailed to entrants after August 1.

- ▶ QGGH members may enter five (5) items; non-QGGH members may enter three (3). Entry fee for QGGH members is \$10 per item. For non-QGGH members, entry fee is \$20 per item. Entry fees are non-refundable after August 15.
- ▶ If entry is to be mailed/shipped back to entrant, a \$20 fee must be included with entry form.
- ▶ Each entry may have only ONE entrant. The name on the "Entrant" line must match the release signature on the form. Entrant must either be the owner of the item entered or must have been involved in the making of the item.
- ▶ Each Entrant will receive a receipt for items checked in. Receipt MUST be present to reclaim items. No entry will be released without a receipt. All entries must remain on display for the entire show. Persons other than entrant picking up entries after the show must have receipt and permission in writing from the entrant to pick up.
- ▶ Entries may not have been displayed in any quilt show in the State of Texas within the last five years.
- ▶ This is not a juried show, so space permitting, all quilts submitted and meeting the submission criteria will be accepted.
