

As we get closer to our long anticipated quilt show, let us make sure we are all on the same page and offer some clarifying information.

1. **All quilts (larger than 10” wide) must have a 4” sleeve for hanging.** If your quilt is longer than 86”, the sleeve needs to be positioned at 86” from the bottom of the quilt. If the sleeve is temporary, or you only want 1 sleeve on your quilt, put the sleeve at the 86” from the bottom. To simplify the measurement, you can measure from the top. For example if your quilt is 100” long, measure down 14” from the top and put your sleeve there. It will be 86” from the bottom. The top of the quilt will then be flipped over behind the hanging bar. We only need 1 sleeve to hang the quilt, which should be positioned so that the quilt will not drag the floor when hung.
2. **Please cover the label on your quilt if it is being judged.** You may baste the cover or pin it with safety pins or cover with blue painters tape. These covers are to provide anonymity during judging. If your quilt is not being judged you do not need to cover the label. We will have blue painters tape at check-in if the maker wishes to put it over their label. If the maker wishes to remove the cover before the show, they may do so on hanging day (September 8) before their quilt is hung. QGGH volunteers will not cover or remove the covers over the labels.
3. **You DO NOT need to bring your quilt to check-in in a bag.** If you want to bring it in a bag, that’s okay. Your bag will be returned to you at check-in. Quilts will be stored laying flat and folded in sheets to be carried to the show.
4. **Please check your quilts carefully before turning in.** QGGH volunteers will be checking the following before accepting your quilt:

Quilt is clean

Label covered

Appropriate Sleeve

Tears in quilt

Holes in quilt

Marks on quilt
